Sub: Delegation of Disciplinary Powers in Central Silk Board – reg.

In pursuance of the observation of the Hon'ble Judge in WP No.115048/2017 dated 31-05-2019 that in Minutes of the 111th Board Meeting of the Central Silk Board held on 04-05-2002 that there was no specific resolution regarding delegation of disciplinary powers and no specific resolutions regarding delegation of disciplinary powers from the Member Secretary to the Director is forthcoming. Based on the said observation, the proposal of Delegation of Disciplinary Powers was re-submitted before the 138th Board Meeting held at New Delhi on 31-03-2021 for clear cut approval of the schedule of Disciplinary powers by the Board.

2. In the Minutes of the 138th Board Meeting under item No.18, the Board observed that *"the Joint Director (Admn.), Central Silk Board informed the Board that in the 111th Meeting of the Board, the powers of Appointing Authority in CSB was delegated to both the Member Secretary as well as the Director and Joint Directors of the Central Silk Board. However, currently only Member Secretary has the power of Appointing Authority. It was noticed that though the power of Appointing Authority has been decided in the 111th Board Meeting but no specific approval for the schedule of Disciplinary powers was mentioned. This was pointed out by the Hon'ble Judge in a court case (WP No.15048/2017 dated 31.05.2019). Hence in consultation with the Board's advocate, the proposal re-submitted before the Board for clear cut approval of the schedule of Disciplinary*

power by the Board". After detailed discussion, the Board decided that there would no change in the schedule of Appointing & Disciplinary powers.

3. As such, all the Directorates / Scientist-D, MSSO, Guwahati are hereby informed that there is no change in the schedule of Appointing Authority & Disciplinary powers originally made in the 111th meeting held on 4-5.2002. As per the decision of the 138th Board Meeting held on 31-03-2021 the delegation of Disciplinary powers as circulated by this office vide letter No.CSB-63(13)/83-ES/VIG.Vol.II, dated 02-07-2002(copy enclosed) stands reconfirmed. Accordingly, this Office letter No.CSB-1(9)/2006-VIG.Vol.II, dated 16-09-2019 for having withheld the Disciplinary powers delegated to all the Directorates **stands withdrawn** (copy enclosed).

5. Currently the powers of Appointing Authority are being exercised at Head Office level, therefore, in all cases relating to imposition of Major Penalties under Rule 14 of CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965 all the Directorates are directed to refer the matter to the Headquarter for further decision of the competent authority.

This issues with the approval of the Member Secretary.

Sub: Delegation of disciplinary powers to all the Directors and also to the Joint Director, BTSSO, Bilaspur - Regarding.

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to state that as of now, the Directors of the Board's Research Institutes / Stations have been delegated disciplinary powers to initiate major penalty proceedings against officials up to the rank of Senior Field Assistant and also for initiating minor penalty proceedings against officials from the rank of Technical Assistant up to the rank of Deputy Director. Similarly, the Joint Directors / Deputy Directors holding independent charge of the Board's units have been delegated disciplinary powers to initiate minor penalty proceedings against Group -D officials working under them.

The above delegation of powers have been reviewed and the Board, at its 111th meeting held at Bangalore on 4th May 2002, has approved a proposal for delegating (a) additional disciplinary powers to the Directors of the Board's Research Institutes / Stations (b) disciplinary powers to the Director, Central Office, Central Silk Board, Bangalore (c) additional disciplinary powers to the Joint Director, Basic Tasar Silkworm Seed Organisation, Bilaspur (Chattisgarh). As per the said latest approval of the

Board, the Directors of the Board's Research Institutes / Stations will henceforth function as Disciplinary Authorities for initiating major penalty proceedings against officials from the rank of Safaiwala up to the rank of Superintendent / Senior Research Assistant and against officials holding equivalent ranks and for imposing any of the penalties as prescribed under the CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965 on them. The existing disciplinary powers vested with the Directors of the Board's Research Institutes / Stations for initiating minor penalty proceedings against officials upto the rank of Deputy Director shall stand.

To sum up, consequent to this revised delegation of disciplinary powers, the following arrangements will come into force with immediate effect.

1) The Directors of the Board's Research Institutes / Stations will be competent to initiate major penalty proceedings against officials from the rank of Safaiwala up to the rank of Superintendent / Senior Research Assistant and against officials holding equivalent ranks working under their control and to impose any of the penalties as prescribed under the CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965 on them. The existing disciplinary powers vested with the Directors of the Board's Research Institutes / Stations for initiating minor penalty proceedings against officials upto the rank of Deputy Director shall stand.

2) The Director, Central Office, Central Silk Board, Bangalore will be competent to initiate major penalty proceedings against officials from the rank of Safaiwala up to the rank of Superintendent / Senior Research Assistant and against officials holding equivalent ranks working at Central Office, Board's Regional Offices, Regional Development Offices, Certification Centres, Silkworm Seed Technology Laboratory, Bangalore and at Seribiotech Research Laboratory, Bangalore and to impose any of the penalties as prescribed under the CCS(CCA) Rules, 1965 on them.

3) The Director, Central Office, Central Silk Board, Bangalore will also function as Disciplinary Authority in respect of staff of Research Institutes / Stations whenever the post of Director remains vacant in a particular Research Institute / Station.

4) The Joint Director, BTSSO, Bilaspur will be competent to initiate major penalty proceedings against the officials from the rank of Safaiwala up to the rank of Superintendent / Senior Research Assistant and against officials holding equivalent ranks working under his control and to impose any of the penalties as prescribed under the CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965 on them.

The above said arrangements shall come into force with immediate effect.

However, in the case of disciplinary proceedings which are already going on, status quo ante (i.e. the disciplinary powers delegated vide Central Office letter of even number dated 09-10-1998) will be maintained.

Kindly ensure that all the procedures prescribed under CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965 are strictly adhered to while handling disciplinary cases. All important communications addressed to the delinquent officials Viz., charge sheets / statements of imputations, Orders of appointment of Inquiry Officer / Presenting Officer, forwardal letter of copy of inquiry report and final orders imposing penalties are issued under the signature of the designated Disciplinary Authority only, under intimation to Central Office (by way of marking endorsement of the said communications to Central Office). Officers who have sense of balance and knowledge of rules alone should be appointed as Inquiry Officers / Presenting Officers.

Central Office is required to submit every month to the Ministry monthly returns in respect of the disciplinary cases pending, initiated and disposed off. In order to enable Central Office to submit the requisite returns to the Ministry on time, kindly ensure that the information pertaining to the disciplinary cases initiated at your end in respect of officials working under your control are furnished to Central Office on or before 5th of every month in the prescribed proforma as is being done now.

All appeals preferred by the appellants against the Orders passed by the Directors of the Board's Research Institutes / Stations and by the Joint Director, BTSSO, Bilaspur in their capacity as Disciplinary Authority will have to be referred to the Member Secretary alongwith all relevant documents for disposal by the Appellate Authority (i.e. the Member Secretary).

Sub:- Withholding of Disciplinary Powers - Reg.

I am to refer to the subject cited above. In this regard, please refer to this Office letter No. CSB-63 (13) / 83-ES*/ VIG. Vol. II dated 02-07-2002 vide which all the Directors of the Board's Research Institutes / Stations have been delegated with the Disciplinary Powers to initiate Major Penalty Proceedings against the Officials up to the rank of Senior Field Assistant and also for initiating Minor Penalty Proceedings against the officials from the rank of Technical Assistant up to the rank of Deputy Director. And also the then Joint Director, Basic Tasar Silkworm Seed Organisation, Central Silk Board, Bilaspur have been delegated Disciplinary Powers to initiate Minor Penalty Proceedings against Group-D officials working under them.

In this context, it is to bring to your kind notice that now, due to certain administrative reasons the Competent Authority has ordered to withhold all the Disciplinary Powers delegated to the Directors of the Board's Research

Institutes and to the Scientist-D, Muga Silkworm Seed Organisation, CSB, Guwahati till further Orders. The following guidelines / instructions may please be adhered to while imposing the penalty / initiating the Charge Sheets :-

- (i) For the Cases which are pending at your level for imposing penalties (Major or Minor Penalty Proceedings), the details may be sent to Member Secretary, CSB for further directions.
- (ii) For the fresh issues, i.e. initiating the Disciplinary Cases, the Central Office may be kept informed about the Cases and approval of the Competent Authority, i.e. the Member Secretary, CSB be obtained for the initiation of the Disciplinary Cases.
