ORDER

The Screening of the eligible CSB Scientists as on 30.06.2019 was done by the Internal Screening Committee (constituted in terms of Rule-10 (1) & (2) of Ministry of Textiles, Central Silk Board, Scientist Group 'A' Post, Recruitment Rules, 2013) (hereinafter referred to as "the said rules") based on their Annual Performance Assessment Reports and Annual Work Reports as per the criteria stipulated in Department of Personnel & Training (DoP&T), Govt. of India Office Memorandum No.AB-14017/37/2008-Estt(RR) dated 10.09.2010 and O.M. Nos. AB 14017/32/2013-Estt-(RR) dated 30/07/2014 & 25.02.2019. On the recommendations of the Internal Screening Committee and as per the DoP&T Guidelines, the Scientists who qualified in the Screening were invited for interview before an Assessment Committee (constituted in terms of Rule-11 (1) & (2) of the said rules) on 15/10/2019 at Central Office, Central Silk Board, Bengaluru to assess their suitability for in-situ promotion to the next higher grade under Modified Flexible Complementing Scheme (MFCS).

2. As per Rule 28(1) (i) of Central Silk Board Rules, 1955, the list of qualified scientists and recommendations of the Assessment Committee were forwarded to Ministry being the Appointing Authority for approval. The Ministry has conveyed the approval vide letter dated 11th December, 2019.

3. Based on the approval of Ministry and its acceptance of the recommendations of the Assessment Committee, the following Scientists are granted in-situ promotion to the next higher grade w.e.f. 01.01.2020, as per the details given below:-


